

Induced abortion statistics have been prepared in Ohio since 1976. The 2021 Annual Abortion Report presents information derived from both the “Confidential Abortion Reports” and “Post-Abortion Care Reports for Complications” in Ohio; reporting forms are included as Appendices I and II. Readers should note that abortion statistics in this report are limited to terminations occurring in Ohio; they do not include Ohio residents who obtained abortions outside the state.

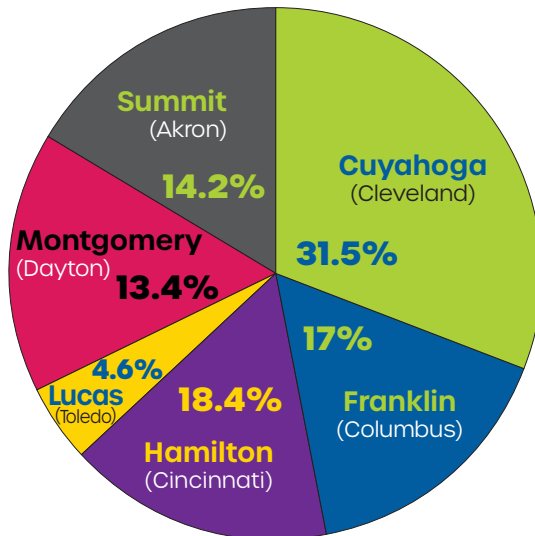

Statewide Characteristics of Ohio Women Who Have Abortions

- **95%** are *residents* of *Ohio*
- **43%** identify as *white*
- **49%** identify as *black*
- **83%** of *women* identify as *single, divorced, or widowed*
- **62%** have *other children*

Characteristics of Women Who Had Abortions in the 19 Counties of Southwest Ohio in 2021

- *Hamilton* and *Montgomery* counties account for **32%** of the state's abortions.
- There were **7,066** abortions performed in *Hamilton* and *Montgomery* counties, of which only **3,596** were residents of those counties.
- *Southwest Ohio* is home to **2** of the most prolific **abortion facilities** in *Ohio*—**Planned Parenthood** and **Women's Med Dayton**.
- *Top resident zip codes for abortion-seeking women* are **45231, 45238, and 45417**.
