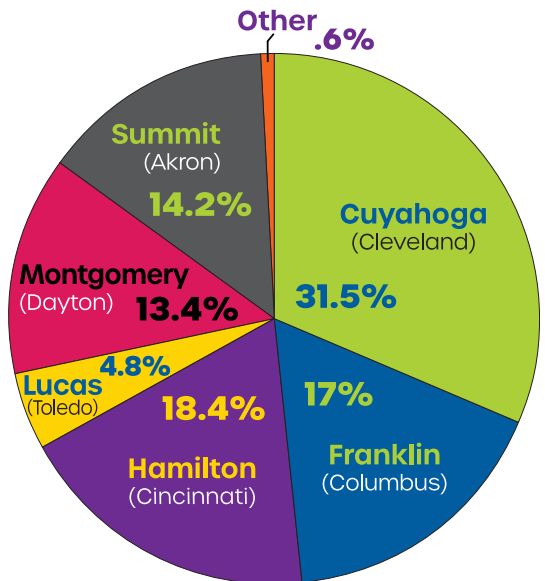

Statewide Characteristics of Ohio Women Who Have Abortions

- **94%** are *residents* of *Ohio*
- **86%** of *women* identify as *single, divorced, or widowed*
- **44%** identify as *white*
- **48%** identify as *black*
- **63%** have *other children*

Characteristics of Women Who Had Abortions in the 15 Counties of Northeast Ohio in 2020

- Total **babies killed 8,508**, a **2.8% increase** from 2019 (during a pandemic when other medical/dental elective services were shut down)
- **43%** of all abortions in Ohio are from women in these **15 counties** making **Northeast Ohio the deadliest place for unborn children in Ohio** (2% increase from 2019)
- **Cuyahoga County** residents account for **51%** of the area's abortions
- There were **9,413 babies killed** by abortion in **Cuyahoga** and **Summit Counties** (though only **5,102** were residents of those counties).
- **Cuyahoga** and **Summit Counties** are the **deadliest counties** for unborn children in the state of Ohio accounting for **46%** of **ALL abortions in Ohio**.
- **African American women** had **62%** of all abortions in **Cuyahoga** and **Summit Counties** in 2020. That translates to **3,551 black children lost to abortion** in Northeast Ohio in one year—over **68 babies every week!**
- The **3 deadliest zip codes** for unborn Ohio children are in **Northeast Ohio. #1: 44105 #2: 44104 #3: 44102**

Induced abortion statistics have been prepared in Ohio since 1976. The 2020 Annual Abortion Report presents information derived from both the “Confidential Abortion Reports” and “Post-Abortion Care Reports for Complications” in Ohio; reporting forms are included as Appendices I and II. Readers should note that abortion statistics in this report are limited to terminations occurring in Ohio; they do not include Ohio residents who obtained abortions outside the state.
